This statement provides outlook for planned projects along three water asset classes:


- Desalination plants,

Desalinated water production via strategic partners (%)




The development of this statement builds on a number of water policies notably

Sewage Treatment Demand






Forecast of water produced/ consumed in KSA

KSA Population Forecast (in Mn)




KSA Total Wastewater Generated (in Mn m³/day)






Pre feasibility study which examines at high level the project's need and it's other associated aspects, commercial, legal and financial structure.

File 1 is subject to approval of the Supervisory Committee.


